

EARLY LITERACY ACTIVITIES

Dinosaur Book

Read a book with dinosaurs in it.

Alphabet Fossil Dig

Hide lettered rocks or "bones" in a sandbox.
When children find a rock, they name the letter,
enhancing both letter recognition
and fine motor skills.

Dino Stomp Syllables

Say names of dinosaurs and stomp the syllables.

Roaring Rhymes

Say a word (like "nest") and have child roar
a rhyming word (like "best").

Finish & return to the library to earn:

- **1 Prize Entry**
- **1 Dino Stuffy**
- **1 Coupon for Free Ice-cream from McDonald's**

Act it out dinosaur style

Read a dinosaur book and stomp, roar, and move like a dinosaur.

Chomp Chomp

At dinner talk about the food you are eating
and the different things dinosaurs eat.

Ask questions like does a T-Rex eat meat or veggies?

Paleontologist Play

Act out being a paleontologist.

Dig for "bones", "dinosaur eggs", and fossils.

Sensory Writing Trays

Fill a tray with sand, salt, or dirt.

Have toddlers use their fingers or
small sticks to trace letters or dinosaur tracks
(like a shape for a three-toed dino).

Draw and color a picture of you
and your pet dinosaur!
